To complete the application process please forward us the following:

- 1. Name of product / service you wish to enter
- 2. 100 words about the product / service
- 3. Attach any leaflet / brochure to support your entry (if available)
- 4. Please attach a High Resolution Image
- 5. Please send a Video Link if available
- 6. Please state the Relevant Award Category for entry
- 7. Finally state if you qualify as a Start Up

JUDGING SCORING SYSTEM

Innovatory aspects of the product / service in relation to dairy farming	50%
Practicality of product / service in assisting with common dairy farming chores/problems	25%
Presentation of product / service	9%
Availability and ability of attendant staff to present, explain and answer questions	8%
Product / service promotes sound agricultural practice or technique in any aspect of dairy farming	8%



OUTLINE RULES FOR THE NATIONAL DAIRY INNOVATION AWARD

All entered Products/Services must have relevance to the dairy farming industry.

All entered Products/Services must have been launched on the Irish market within 12 months prior to Show date unless eligible to enter in the start-up category or other reason deemed acceptable by awards

Start Up must be in the first year of trading or still in the development phase

All entered Products/Services must be presented at the National Dairy Show

All entries for the Awards must be entered before 6th October 2023

All exhibitors must be in accordance with the National Dairy Show trade exhibitor terms and regulations

Category selections of organisers are final. The judges' decision is final and cannot be contested. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entries without explanation.

The organising committee takes no responsibility for any wrong information in any publication regarding the entries into the Awards.

Submission of an entry is taken as acceptance of these rules.
